We are pleased to announce the launch of the international project “Competences for Future Logistics in V4 Countries”, officially started in February 2025, and supported by the International Visegrad Fund. The project aims to enhance future-oriented competences in the logistics sector, responding to the growing demands of a VUCA (Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity, Ambiguity) world. It focuses on applying foresight and futures literacy approaches to education and training. The project is implemented by a consortium of four partner institutions from the Visegrad region:

1. Hungary – Corvinus University of Budapest
2. Poland – Jan Kochanowski University of Kielce
3. Czech Republic – Tomas Bata University in Zlín
4. Slovakia – University of Žilina
